We are very excited to have Mr. Virgil Hobbs to be our guest speaker for our November meeting. His topic on "Environmental Challenges for a Sustainable Water & Energy Future" centers on the operations and maintenance of hydroelectric power programs. Under the supervision of US Army Corps of Engineers, the first hydroelectric plant was built in the 1920's. Today, the Corps operates about 75 power plants, producing one-fourth of the nation's hydro-electric power.

Mr. Hobbs was the Chief of Hydropower Division under the Corps. He administered Savannah District's hydropower program. He and his team provided engineering equipment evaluation, assessment, improvement, and education support to Savannah, Wilmington and Charleston District's multi-purpose projects.

Currently, as Hartwell Project Operations Manager, he is responsible for balancing resources for competing projects of Navigation, Recreation, Environmental Stewardship, Hydropower, Water Supply, and Flood Damage Reduction.
