**Directions to the Madren Center from I-85:**  
 Take I-85 South to exit 19B. Go approx. 10 miles towards Clemson. After passing the National Guard Armory on the right, take a left onto Perimeter Road (if you see Rt. 93 you have gone too far). At the first stoplight, take a left onto Cherry Road. Take the first right onto Old Stadium Road, and the Madren Center is approximately 0.25 mile on the left.

**Directions to the Madren Center from 123:**  
 Take 123 South to the Rt. 93 exit. Take a left at the traffic light onto Rt. 93. Go approx. 1 mile and exit onto Rt. 76 (towards Anderson). Take the first right onto Perimeter Road. At the first stoplight, take a left onto Cherry Road. Take the first right onto Old Stadium Road and the Madren Center is approx. 1/4 mile on the left.
